Students are entitled to a commercial license after completion of the course. License holders may act as pilot in command for hire or compensation.

PREREQUISITES

1. Must be 17 years old by check ride
2. Ability to speak, understand and write in English
3. Qualify for a 2nd Class FAA Medical Certificate
4. Proof of financial capacity to complete the program
